Description of housing: Multiple onsite cabins available for participants. Cabins include one room with two or three beds for participants of the same gender to share. Restrooms and hot water sink are located close by -- please see employer website and view facility map for more information. Participants also have free access to resort hot springs bathhouse for showers and bath. Bedding and linens are provided. Couples who are hired will have their choice of sharing cabins with others or

having their own one-room cabin. A kitchen is not available in the cabins, but 2 meals (lunch and dinner) are provided in the Resort cafe. An ice chest is also provided for food items for breakfast in the cabin. Participants will have access to a microwave/hot plate. If a participant quits or is fired, they will have approximately 48 hours to vacate employer provided housing.

Job description

Participants will be expected to help in many areas of the Resort doing a variety of tasks on the property. Housekeeping: Participants will be cleaning cabin rooms and common areas (sometimes every day). They will vacuum carpets, sweep floors, wash windows, scrub toilets and clean with cleaning chemicals. Participants will make the beds and wash, dry and fold laundry for the rooms approximately 6 hours per week. Laundry duties will not exceed 15% of weekly hours. Sometimes housekeeping employees will be asked to wait on customers in the restaurant, handle and prepare food, wash dishes, clean and work in the general store. Participants should understand that the Resort is in a remote area. Participants occasionally get the opportunity to go to Fresno, CA. Employer requests that interested participants visit the employer's website to get a feel for the location and type of business before applying.
