**Job Descriptions:**

**Backservers** deliver bread, water and food to tables, clear dishes, make specialty coffees, polish glassware and silverware.

**Hosts** greet and seat guests, assist with clearing and resetting tables, and take telephone reservations.

**Housepersons** polish glassware and silverware, and set-up and breakdown tables and chairs for private events.

**Breakfast Attendants** will assist in the setup and breakdown of breakfast. They will help answer customer questions and ensure that food is properly stocked and organized.

**Work Hours:** You should expect to work an average of **32 - 40 hours/week**. Employees will be assigned a specific schedule each week. Requests for specific days can be made and accommodated based on business demands. Hours are subject to business demands. All available positions are in Food and Beverage so if the restaurant is not busy, employees may be sent home early. Peak business months of June, July and August will provide a minimum of 32 hours per week and in September if business slows employees will be offered the opportunity to pick up shifts in another restaurant on the hotel property.

**Work Start Dates:** You should plan your U.S. arrival so you can begin working **May 24 – June 1**. June 1 is the absolute latest you can arrive.

**Work Finish Dates:** We are looking for candidates who can finish working **September 10 - September 30**. You should be as upfront and honest as possible about your work finish date. It is customary in the U.S. to give at least two weeks notice of your final day of work.

**Uniform:** We provide all uniform clothing. You must bring black work shoes, black socks, & black belt.

**Housing Information:** There are two options for housing. Housing can be dorm style with up to two people per bedroom or four bedroom apartments where each person has their own bedroom and shares the rest of the apartment. Costs range from \$350 per month to \$650 per month (**\$87.50 - \$162.50/week**). Housing costs are paid directly to the rental company. The **security deposit is \$600 and it is refundable** if the apartment is clean and in good condition upon move out.

### Area Descriptions:

Surrounded by many of Colorado's most beautiful mountain peaks, this still-small town is home to some of life's biggest experiences. Summer adventures are impressive here - from premier fly fishing to whitewater rafting to weekly rodeos that start the great-great grandkids of the ranchers that settled this valley more than a century ago. Around Snowmass you'll find more than 90 miles of hiking, biking and equestrian trails and 27 holes of scenic disc golf. Concerts rock the village year round, and the summer is full of festivals, events, and big-name acts on world famous stages.
