Participants will be promoted to lifeguard position upon successful completion of Swim Test and Lifeguard Training. \*\* Lifeguard Training Cost: \$250 USD All Premier Aquatics employees are required to obtain a Pool Operator's License in addition to Lifeguard Training and CPR Certifications.
