Position Description

Food and Beverage Assistant: To ensure that guests are provided with drinks and food when requested. To ensure the Restaurant service is at a quality at all times. To complete cleaning and preparation to ensure a smooth service. Will include bussing tables, running food, taking orders, prepping food as needed.

Pool/Beach Attendant: Performs guest safety and recreational work supervising, swimming and enforcing regulations at a hotel pool as well as providing for the guest-s comfort. An essential responsibility of this role includes ensuring cleanliness, setting -up and safety of all areas and facilities and attend to all guests needs within the hotel pool area as per the safety guidelines of the hotels management

Housekeeping: •Perform a variety of cleaning activities such as sweeping, mopping, dusting and polishing •Ensure all rooms are cared for and inspected according to standards •Notify superiors on any damages, deficits and disturbances •Check stocking levels of all consumables and replace when appropriate •Adhere strictly to rules regarding health and safety and be aware of any company-related practices
