All students will need to provide a refundable security deposit of \$250 upon arrival. RENT IS COLLECTED ON A WEEKLY BASIS AND WILL VARY BY MONTH. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: May - \$125/month (pro-rated for partial month) June - \$300/month (pro-rated for partial month) July - \$500/month (pro-rated for partial month) September - \$250/month (pro-rated for partial month) "Pro-rated for partial month" means that your employer will only charge you for the amount of days or weeks you lived in the housing during your arrival and departure period.
