Participants will share park owned, fully furnished houses adjacent to the Park. Each participant will share room, up to 2 per room, with separate beds.

PLEASE NOTE: Housing is to be assigned on availability at discretion of manager; friends and couples should not expect to live together as housing is divided strictly by gender.

The Rides Operator is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of one or more of

Canobie Lake Park's rides.

- This is a physical position involving bending over and occasional lifting of empty two-person water raft
- Team Members must be willing to accept the responsibilities of working with the public, as they will be working directly with Park guests, including small children and their parents.
- Team Members perform all duties including:
- o Watching the ride or activity
- o Operating any necessary controls
- o Assisting guests
- o Communicating safety instructions
- o Answering questions
- o Assisting guests as they exit and enter the ride
- o Cleaning the entire ride area
- o Occasionally assisting guests off the ride using stairs and/or ladders
