Job benefits, bonuses, or incentives offered by your company (if any):

Dorm-style housing is provided for \$93/week with three free meals provided daily in the employee cafeteria. Participants living onsite have access to GTLC's recreation program where activities are planned for employees to participate in. These include hiking, poker night, bingo, exercise classes, sports tournaments (e.g. basketball, softball, volleyball) and many other activities. End of season bonuses of \$4/day are available for all resort worker positions. Bonuses are given based upon participant completion of their work agreement dates, good end of season evaluation and are eligible for re-hire upon departure. Employees can do all guest activities for free including horseback riding, raft trips, interpretive bus tours and lake cruises. Employees receive 20% discount in retail shops on or off the clock. Also there are discounts in town for free entrance to the wildlife museum and other discounts throughout Jackson. Please see Additional Comments for more information.

Additional Hiring Requirements:

Participants must fill out an online application before starting work. A specific link to the application will be provided after participants have been hired through Greenheart Exchange. Background check could be required based on

conviction question in the application. Background check will be paid for by the employer. **IMPORTANT!!:** Although participants may work a 2nd job outside of Grand Teton Lodge Company, obtaining and committing to a 2nd job is not always feasible. GTLC is 35 miles from the nearest town, and the transportation schedule is limited. If availability permits, employees could be approved (based on satisfactory work performance in their primary job) to work additional hours in a different department within the company. However availability of department hours will be determined by employer business needs. Please note any secondary positions cannot interfere with primary position schedules.

Housing, Meals and Transportation

Description of housing: Each property and site of activity has their own housing available on site. Each property has dorms with around 20 rooms with 2-5 people per room. Each participant will have their own bed. There are large communal bathrooms separated by gender in each dorm with several sinks, showers and toilets. These are older dorm rooms and are very basic facilities in a National Park. Participants need to be aware of this. Laundry facilities are included free of charge. WiFi is available in most of the dorms and locations, but due to remote nature it is not guaranteed in the rooms at all times. There are computers and internet available to use at each property. The housing areas are considered 'villages' and allow participants to interact closely with all the fellow employees daily. If participant quits and/or is fired they will be required to leave employer provided housing within 24 hours. A microwave is available for participants to use in the employee cafeteria.

For ALL positions listed participants should expect to stand for long periods of of time (8-10 hours). Participants must be willing to work in any of the positions listed. They should not expect to choose their favorite position, although they can request it. Housekeeper: Cleaning guest rooms or public areas; vacuuming, cleaning bathrooms, making beds, mopping and other duties associated with cleaning. Participants will use cleaning chemicals. Must be able to bend, crouch, crawl, stoop, and kneel for extended periods of time. Accommodations include both cabins and cottage rooms. For more information please visit the website: <http://www.gtlc.com/lodges> Dishwasher: Perform daily cleaning of dishes, pot sinks, silverware, glassware, garbage disposal areas, kitchen and food preparation equipment including pots and pans, and employee cafeteria kitchen and kitchen bathrooms. Cleaning dishes and cooking utensils will consist of hand washing and the use of commercial washing machine. Employees perform strenuous repetitive tasks while standing for extended periods of time. Prep Cook: Responsible for preparation of food products for cooking and serving within restaurants, including: cutting, chopping, and dicing vegetables, using sharp knives. Employee Dining Room Assistant: Serving food to employees in the employee dining room, cleaning the cafeteria, wiping tables, sweeping and mopping floor, food preparation for salad bar and stocking food for employees to eat. Please note: Overtime of time and a half is given after 56 hours worked in a week. See Additional Comments for more details regarding each position.
