Participants will be working at one of the park fun centers (ex. Arcade, Bait Shop, Pool, Store, etc.) Job responsibilities within the Fun Center Attendant is split, based on business needs, among the following jobs: Store Clerk - Clerking - Running POS (Point of Sale system)/cash register -Scanning items for sale - Taking money - Taking orders for cafe food service - Scooping of ice cream - Restocking inventory as needed - Cleaning up is required during all shifts Arcade Attendant - Running POS (Point of Sale system)/cash register - Scanning items for sale - Tending to guests at the desk - Distributing rental sports equipment - Issuing prizes for coupon redemption - Cleaning up is required during all shifts Pool Attendant - Performing pool tests (pump controls and water chemistry) - Participants will be trained to work with chemicals - Clean and maintain pool deck and lounge chairs - PLEASE NOTE: Pool Attendants are required to be in the water to do cleaning. Knowing how to swim is not required. Job description

The Housekeeping staff is responsible for cleaning and maintaining various resort buildings and rental units in order to ensure guest have a positive experience. Key areas of responsibility: • Work closely with Housekeeping Manager and Maintenance Manager • Adhere to Pine Acres policies and procedures listed in Employee Manual • Friendly and helpful towards co-workers • Maintain a friendly, courteous, and professional manner at all times • Complete daily and weekly cleaning tasks • Clean bathroom facilities, including toilets • Clean rental units upon departure in an efficient manner to ensure unit is ready for the next guest • Work as a member of a team • Fill out any service slips for broken or missing items • Promote Resort services, activities, and have the ability to answer customer questions Participants will be responsible for cleaning: Rustic Cabins (15) - 300 square feet - Cleaned daily as needed - Average per day is 4-6 units - These units have no kitchen or bath so they take a maximum of 45 minutes to clean Recreation Vehicle (RV)s (4) -30 foot x 8.5 foot - During our Summer season these units rent Friday to Friday so all four are cleaned by Housekeeping on Fridays (2 teams to complete 4 RVs and bathroom rounds) Lodge Function Hall - 1,500 square feet - This is used for functions so the floor is swept and mopped after one function to prepare for the next. Bathroom Buildings - Numerous buildings and all different sizes. Participants will be using cleaning chemicals. This department works closely with Maintenance and is sometimes asked to work as Junior Maintenance team-member. In this role participants will be doing light work around the campground such as raking leaves, picking up trash, quality assurance of park grounds and delivering newspapers to guests. Participants will not be using heavy machinery or heavy maintenance work; participants will be in constant interaction with Americans and working in teams.
