6 participants will be housed in 2 travel trailers with slide out doors. There is one set of bunk beds with a partition and one single bed in each. Each unit has a

kitchen stocked with pots, pans, utensils, dishes, refrigerator, and a microwave. There are 2 TVs in each unit, a dining room, living area, and 1 bathroom in each with a shower. The bathrooms are stocked with linens and towels. Additional showers/bathhouses will also be a short distance away. If a participant resigns they need to vacate housing within 24 hours of their last shift. As resignations are pre-planned they are responsible for making their own arrangements. If participants are terminated they need to vacate within 24 hours

of termination.

Job description

1. Tests and balances pool chemicals. Documents as required by state and local regulations. Tests water and adds chemicals as needed. 2. Monitors and adjusts pool temperature as directed. 3. Cleans and vacuums pool. Cleans skimmer baskets. Back wash's pool filters. Skims pool with skimmer as needed. 4. Monitors individuals entering and leaving the pool area. Ensures state capacity is not exceeded. 5. Ensures pool bathrooms are clean, stocked with supplies and free of standing water. 6. Ensures all posted pool rules are being adhered to. 7. Ensures safety equipment is present and in working order. Check first aid kit for needed supplies on daily basis. 8. Sweeps pool deck and all surrounding areas daily. 9. Straightens pool furniture regularly, ensuring that furniture is clean and in working order at all times. 10. Cleans clubhouse and surrounding common areas as needed. 11. Gardens and pulls weeds in commons areas as needed. 12. Handles guest and resident questions and complaints directly or refers them to the appropriate department. 13. Provides guests with accessibility by patrolling the resort frequently and assisting them when needed. 14. Delivers special packages and/or one-day mail to appropriate sites. 15. Assists with coverage of the main gate when needed. 16. Routinely checks swimming pool(s) for unregistered guests, if applicable. 17. Tags vehicles for removal by owner at unrented transient sites. 18. Follows safety procedures while performing duties. 19. Other duties as assigned. Gardening will be less than 10% of job duties.
