Free Canobie Lake Park admission (Season Pass). NEAAPA Pass, which provides free entry to many amusement parks and attractions in the New England area, is given to all Team Members. 25% off of all food while working. Team Member parties in the park and cultural activities, including Vegas Night, Awards Night, Minute to Win It/game show night. Gift certificates and bonuses issued at discretion of managers for good work performance. Movie passes for local cinema for exemplary service. Weekly trips scheduled to local attractions; for example Beach, Boston, White Mountains for hiking/site seeing, and many more based on feedback of participants.

Additional Hiring Requirements: PLEASE NOTE: Friends and couples are welcome to apply, but should not expect to have the same shifts or days off. Further, housing is assigned based on availability at the discretion of manager; friends and couples should not expect to live together as housing is divided strictly by gender. Possession of alcohol or being under the influence of alcohol, or the possession of drugs or being under the influence of drugs while on duty is not tolerated. Canobie Lake Park is a drug-free work place. Testing for illegal drugs or alcohol may be conducted

randomly during employment at no charge to the employee. Completion of orientation upon arrival and documents including necessary US tax forms and the I-9 are required. Orientations are paid and must be completed prior to beginning training or work. As orientations are paid, participants cannot attend orientation prior to their DS-2019 start date. Participants are asked to please remember to bring their passports and DS-2019 form to the orientation. If participants have a Social Security card, they need to bring this document as well. Canobie Lake Park conducts background checks on all employees; no fee is charged for this service. Details will be reviewed at orientation. Participants are encourage to bring all questions to their manager.

Job description

Food Service Workers will be assigned to one of the 23 food service locations throughout Canobie Lake Park, based on skill set and need of the Park. Food Service Workers serve and replenish food from counters and steam tables and break down stations at the end of meal periods. Additional responsibilities include: clean and sanitize work stations, counters, steam tables and other equipment setting up stations with condiments and utensils brewing coffee and tea interaction with guests reading recipes and/or product directions estimating food requirements operating a variety of kitchen utensils to weigh, measure, mix, wash, peel, cut, grind, stir, strain, season and knead ingredients for cooking, serving and storing assisting in the preparation of foods inspecting work stations for compliance with service standards keeping records and requisition for supplies/equipment operating a cash register (or equivalent) receiving payments of cash, checks and charges from Guests or Team Members for goods or services, making change and issuing receipts. Participants must be flexible to work a variety of tasks/shifts and work on weekends and holidays. Participants must also have the ability to work at a fast pace and must enjoy being outdoors. Participants will be using cleaning chemicals. Participants will be in daily contact with American guests and American co-workers.
