Job Descriptions: There are 32 total positions available.

Retail Sales Helpers will be selling and restocking shelves, sales.

- The wage is \$9.00 \$10.00/hour.
- There are 4 positions available.

Dishwashers will be washing dishes, cutlery, utensils, pots, pans.

- The wage is \$11.00/hour.
- There are 4 positions available.

Public Area Attendants will be maintaining grounds, keeping walk ways clean, picking up trash.

• The wage is \$11.00/hour.

Cooks are responsible for food prep for breakfast, lunch, dinner in either the Jordan Pond House restaurant or the employee dining room.

Maintenance Utility employees will be doing general maintenance work, carpentry, and facility upkeep.

- The wage is \$11.00/hour.
- There is 1 position available.

Work Schedule: You should expect to work about **40 hours per week** on average. You can count on your department managers to assign schedules bi-weekly.

Work Start Dates: You should plan your U.S. arrival so you can begin working June 1 – June 15.

Work Finish Dates: We are looking for candidates who can finish work **August 30 – September 30.** You should be as upfront and honest about your final day of work. It is customary in the U.S. to give at least two weeks notice.

Uniform: Comfortable Khaki cotton shorts or pants that you don't mind getting dirty; A mostly white pair of skid-resistant shoes/tennis shoes. No sandals; A pair of brown or black casual shoes. No sandals; Women please bring plain white socks; men please bring dark socks and plain white socks.

Interviews: We are looking to hire 16 males and 16 females. We can interview friend groups, but we are unable to hire couples as a group.





Housing Information: Housing and meals are provided for approximately \$100 per week. You will be living in a dormitory within walking distance of the restaurant. You will be living in a rustic setting, 4 people per bunkroom. 8 people will share a very small common room. You will share a dorm style bathroom with all the students on your floor. You are required to keep your living space clean according to National Park standards; rooms are inspected weekly. Men and women live on separate floors. Meals (cooked by the dorm cook) are included. There are no cooking facilities in dorm rooms. Rent also includes free laundry and detergent, shampoo, conditioner, soap, and lotion. Linens and towels are available by request.

The dorm is located in Acadia National Park, about 8 miles from the town of Bar Harbor, Maine.

Area Description: The restaurant is located in beautiful Acadia National Park in a rustic, wooded environment. Hiking, biking, and exploring the outdoors are always available. Swimming is about 2 miles away. The main town, Bar Harbor, is small. It is about 8 miles away. You can find plenty of shopping and activities in town and on the island. Museums, art festivals, music performances, and National Park educational programs can be found. The nearest city is Bangor, 1 hour away. There are plenty of young students working and living together, you will have a great summer meeting people and enjoying the outdoors.



Job Descriptions: There are 6 total positions available. There will be a \$1.00/hour bonus for hours worked (minus overtime hours), if full contract dates are honored.

Retail staff will be stocking, cashiering, and assisting guests with purchases.

- The wage is \$11.00/hour.

Cafe staff will be bussing, cashiering, and assisting with food prep.

- The wage is \$11.00/hour.

Work Hours: You should expect to work at least **40 hours per week**. Overtime will be available in the busier times. Managers schedule bi-weekly shifts in advance.

Work Start Dates: You should plan your U.S. arrival so you can begin working June 1 – June 15.





Work Finish Dates: We are looking for candidates who can finish working August 15 – September 10.

Uniform: Students should provide khaki (retail) or black (cafe) pants and a polo style work shirt will be provided. Closed toe shoes (non slip in the restaurant).

Interviews: Due to the housing set up, male participants are preferred for this location.

Housing Information: Housing cost is **\$85 per week**, per person with a **refundable \$100 housing deposit**. Housing is a 3 bedroom, 1 bath house with living, kitchen area. There will be two students to each room. Housing is 45 minutes from the job site, but free shuttle transportation will be provided.

Mammoth Cave Lodge is a national park concessioner that operates lodging, food and beverage and retail operations in the Mammoth Cave National Park.

Job Descriptions: There are 14 total positions available.

Retail Associates are responsible for stocking, cashiering, and assisting guests with purchases

- The wage is \$9.00 per hour + monthly sales bonus.
- There are 4 positions available.





Housekeepers are responsible for cleaning cottages and hotel rooms.

- The wage is \$9.00/hour.
- There are 6 positions available.

Food & Beverage Associates may do food prep, cashier, or bus tables.

- The wage is \$9.00/hour.
- There are 4 positions available.

Work Hours: You should expect to work about **40 hours per week** on average. Managers organize department schedules a week in advance. Department managers will communicate any changes, usually 48 hours in advance.

Work Start Dates: You should plan your U.S. arrival so you can begin working May 15 – June 15.

Work Finish Dates: We are looking to hire candidates who can finish working August 15 – September 15.

Uniform: Employees are expected to wear brown or tan khaki pants, knee length shorts or capris with closed toe shoes when working in areas other than the restaurants. If working in the restaurant, employees must wear black pants and no-slip work shoes. The company will provide polo shirts with logo.

Interviews: We are able to interview and hire friend groups and couples. However couples may not be housed together.

Housing Information: Housing will cost \$100.00 per person, per week, with a \$100 refundable housing deposit. The housing is dorm style. There are 10 rooms in one building. Two employees will share a room. Each room will have two twin beds or bunk beds, a dresser, a closet, and a TV. Two rooms will be connected by a bathroom in the middle. Employees are expected to provide their own linens for their twin size beds and towels for the bathroom. The common area will have a seating area, a full size refrigerator, stove, microwave and washer/ dryer and a TV. There is outside seating with a BBQ area.

Area Description: A number of cultural trips and activities will be planned that may include shopping and sightseeing in nearby Nashville Tennessee, the famous landmark of country music! Uniform: Black/Tan pants with closed toe shoes. You will need non-slip shoes if you are working in the cafe. Work polo shirts will be issued.

Interviews: We are able to interview and hire friend groups and couples, however couples may not be housed together.

Housing Information: Housing will cost \$150.00 per person, per week, with a \$50 refundable housing deposit. Housing is a 4-bedroom house with 2 baths, full kitchen and living area. There will be 2 students to a room with twin beds. The housing is a 45 minute drive from the job site, but transportation will be provided free of charge from the housing to the job site.
