	motel. Each room has 2 bunk beds, for up to 4 participants total. Each room has 1 bathroom, which all participants in the room will share. Each room includes a mini-refrigerator and a microwave. The housing is located within walking distance to the employer and to local restaurants, bakeries and other eating establishments. If a participant is fired or quits their job at Roberto's Italian Ice, they may still continue to live at the motel, as long as they continue to pay rent.

Job description

Participants will be assigned to work at the employer's location at the Family Kingdom Amusement Park (300 Ocean Blvd). Participants will be selling Italian ice to customers. They should be outgoing and friendly and able to interact and communicate with guests. Participants must be able to describe flavors and answer questions. Participants must be comfortable starting up conversations and selling the product. Participants need to be familiar with American currency and be able to conduct accurate cash and credit card transactions. Participants need to be comfortable working outside in the weather, regardless of the temperature. During the summer, the weather is typically hot and humid during hours when participants will be working. Participants will be paid an hourly wage of \$8.50 per hour. At the end of the season, a \$0.25 per hour worked bonus will be given to participants who complete their job requirements and work with the employer until their DS-2019 End Date. If participants stop work prior to their DS-2019 End Date, they will not be eligible for the \$0.25 per hour worked bonus.
