Job description

As a Server, participants will be taking customers' orders, serving food and beverages, preparing itemized checks, accepting payment and bussing tables. Servers may perform additional duties, which may include escorting guests to tables, serving customers seated at counters, setting up and clearing tables, and operating a computer based system for making orders and processing payment as well as hosting guests and cleaning of necessary buffet area and wait station. Servers (also known as wait staff) must be professional, polite, and reliable. They must speak excellent English to be able to understand and converse with the customers and they must be able to learn and describe food proficiently. Wait Staff also need to be familiar with the menu, with how the food is prepared, what it tastes like and if special requests are allowed. They need to be informed about specials and special events. Employment of being a Server is based on your training and abilities and guest comments. Shifts are assigned based on ability and Servers may be assigned other jobs if unable to perform the necessary duties of a Server. Should they not be able to the duties as assigned, they will be offered a different position. There is no guarantee of a specific job if the applicant is not able to perform the duties.
