Description of housing: Participants will live in a fully-furnished, 4 bedroom house. There will be up to 3 participants per bedroom. All participants will have their own bed. The home has one bathroom which is to be shared by all participants. Bedding is provided to the participants. The housing includes a full kitchen, living room, dining room, and outdoor patio with 2 outdoor showers. Participants will have access to a washer and dryer, which is located in the house. There is also a garage available to participants for storage. If participants are terminated from their job

they are expected to move out of the provided housing within a week (7 days).

Job description

The Galley Counter positions operate from the company's many whale watching boats. Participants' primary job duty is to serve passengers food and beverages while on the boat. Other job duties include keeping passengers safe, maintaining cabin cleanliness and keeping the galley stocked with necessary food/beverage items. All employees are required to have a friendly and professional attitude and be comfortable interacting with the public. There is usually downtime during the day to enjoy the views, whales and marine wildlife while out to sea. Participants may be using cleaning chemicals. Participants should also be prepared to stand for long periods of time while working. **Participants are paid per boat trip they work. Each boat trip shift is about 4 hours long. They will make \$50 a trip. At minimum participants will be working 8 trips per week, receiving a minimum of 32 hours a week on average. Participants should be aware that this job is very dependent on weather. If weather does not allow for boat tours to happen then participants may still be asked to work cleaning the boats and dock area.
